As Writers and Readers we will:

- Continue to work on our Phase 5 phonic sounds
- Continue to work on reading and writing our high frequency words
- Learn to use alliteration in a sentence
- Learn to research a sea creature and make this into a fact file
- Write fiction stories about sea creatures
- Focus on reading with expression and for meaning
- Continue to write using adjectives and conjunctions
- Find the rhyming words in poetry
- Recap all of our punctuation, spelling and grammar we have learnt so far and use this in our writing

Computing

- We will be focusing on programming.
- We will continue to talk about e-safety
- We will be using paint to create sea life pictures
- We will be using phonics play to help with our phase 5 sounds

As Mathematicians we will:

- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number; count on and back in twos, fives and tens
- Count, read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words; read and write numbers to at least 100
- Given a number, identify one more and one less
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 100
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects and pictorial representations
